RE: AUTHORIZATION TO SELL SURPLUS VEHICLES IN THE WEST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT
DATE: MAY 18, 2023

Before the Board of Supervisors this evening is a request for authorization to sell the 2010 Skid Steer Loader in the West Goshen Township Public Works Department. As part of the Township's 2023 budget, a new skid steer loader was allocated, with new piece of equipment being received on March 30, 2023. Previously, the Township had traded in this type of equipment; however, given the condition of the previous skid steer loader and the attachments, it may be more advantageous to pursue auctioning the item. Mark Bertolami, Streets Superintendent, researched the recent sale of skid steer loaders on Municibid earlier this year and found the following sales information:

- 2008 Case 445 Skid Steer \$39,600
- 2004 Case Skid Steer \$23,101
- 2002 John Deere \$20,800
- **2009 Cat 262c \$31,900**
- 2003 Cat 226 \$15,000
- 2009 Case 465 \$30,150

Please be advised that the item in bold most closely resembles the model the Township would list for sale. Additionally, at the time of the purchase new skid steer loader, the offered trade-in value of the 2010 Skid Steer Loader was \$37,000. In speaking with Mr. Bertolami, he estimates that the sale of the 2010 Skid Steer Loader would be between \$30,000 and \$45,000, including the attachments that would be included.

If authorized for sale, the skid steer loaded would be placed on Municibid for public auction. The winning bid would be bought back to the Board for approval once the bidding closes.
